PRINCIPLES OF PRAYER

- 1. No believer's spiritual life will rise to stay above the level of their prayer life.
- 2. No church's ultimate effectiveness will rise to stay above the level of its corporate prayer life.
- 3. No church's corporate prayer life will be greater than the personal prayer lives of those who make up its membership.
- 4. No believer's prayer life will rise to stay above the level of his or her own personal, regular, daily time of worship with God.
- 5. Your practice of prayer will never rise above your view of prayer.
- 6. Praise is an indispensable part of a prayer life that is successful.
- 7. The only way to learn to pray is to pray.

- Will you praise God no matter what?
- Are all sins confessed?
- Are all relationships with others made right?
- · Are you seeking his will in all things?
- Are you seeking to glorify God above all things?
- Are you depending on the Holy Spirit's guidance
