Enoch: Walking With God

Genesis 5:21–24 (ESV)

²¹ When Enoch had lived 65 years, he fathered Methuselah.
 ²² Enoch walked with God after he fathered Methuselah 300 years and had other sons and daughters.
 ²³ Thus all the days of Enoch were 365 years.
 ²⁴ Enoch walked with God, and he was not, for God took him.

- 1. Enoch had a <u>beginning point</u> in his walk with God ²² "Enoch walked with God <u>after</u> he fathered Methuselah"
- Enoch was <u>steadfast</u> in his walk with God
 ²² Enoch walked with God after he fathered Methuselah <u>300 years</u>
- 3. Enoch walked with God <u>personally</u> The very word "**walk**," implies a personal relationship.
- 4. Enoch walked with God <u>publicly</u> Hebrews 11:5
 By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him. Now before he was taken he was <u>commended</u> as having pleased God.
- 5. Enoch walked with God prophetically Jude 11,14,15
- 6. Enoch walked in the <u>reality</u> of God Hebrews 11:6
 "whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists"
- 7. Enoch walked by <u>faith</u> Hebrews 11:5 "By faith"
- 8. Enoch walked in the <u>pleasure</u> of God Hebrews 11:5
 "Now before he was taken he was *commended* as having <u>pleased God</u>."
