

Enoch: Walking With God

Genesis 5:21–24 (ESV)

²¹ When Enoch had lived 65 years, he fathered Methuselah.

²² Enoch walked with God after he fathered Methuselah 300 years and had other sons and daughters. ²³ Thus all the days of Enoch were 365 years.

²⁴ Enoch walked with God, and he was not, for God took him.

1. Enoch had a beginning point in his walk with God

²² “Enoch walked with God **after** he fathered Methuselah”

2. Enoch was steadfast in his walk with God

²² Enoch walked with God after he fathered Methuselah **300 years**

3. Enoch walked with God personally

The very word “**walk**,” implies a personal relationship.

4. Enoch walked with God publicly

Hebrews 11:5

By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him.

Now before he was taken he was commended as having pleased God.

5. Enoch walked with God prophetically

Jude 11,14,15

6. Enoch walked in the reality of God

Hebrews 11:6

“whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists”

7. Enoch walked by faith

Hebrews 11:5 “By faith”

8. Enoch walked in the pleasure of God

Hebrews 11:5

“Now before he was taken he was *commended* as having *pleased God*.”
