The Multi-Use of the Law

Three ways to use God's law:

1. Teaching Us How to Live

2. Restraining Sin in Society

3. Revealing Our Need for a Savior

- 1) We are commanded to keep the law that we cannot keep.
- 2) The law has a way of actually provoking our sin.
- 3) Sin leads to death.
- 4) Those who sin and die are under God's curse.

John Calvin wrote that while the law "shows God's righteousness, that is, the righteousness alone acceptable to God, it warns, informs, convicts, and lastly condemns, every man of his own unrighteousness."
