Law 3:Name Above All Names Exodus 20:7

"You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain.

YHWH = Jehovah or Yahweh "I am who I am," or "I will be who I will be."

YHWH is often translated as LORD.

INTERPRETING THE VERSE

"take" literally means to "lift up"

"vain" means thoughtlessly or in an empty way.

MISUSING GOD'S NAME

- * using it as a swear word
- * using it thoughtlessly
- * when we speak and act in ways that betray the relationship with Christ we claim to have.
- * using God's name to advance our own agenda.
- * When we pray in His name without a true conviction that He hears us as we are praying.
- * being careless in our worship.
