A. What do we mean by “once saved, always saved?”

Once God works a work of grace in a person's life, it's permanent.

John 10:28-29

Rom 8:28-39

B. What is God doing in salvation?

1. Salvation is a relationship
– not fire insurance

2. What kind of a relationship?
Two views of salvation:
 - * CONTRACT:
CHRIST + FAITH = Salvation

 - * REGENERATION:
Ephesians 2:4–6
Ephesians 2:8-9

CHRIST (through) FAITH brings Salvation

bilateral covenant versus a unilateral covenant
Hebrews 8:7-13
